



Tribal Regalia

The Sankofa Board of Directors supports the Oklahoma statute, Title 70, 24-160 which states that students enrolled in a public school district or public charter school may wear tribal regalia during the schools' official graduation ceremonies. The Administration shall ensure that school personnel will not prevent students from wearing tribal regalia during official graduation ceremonies.

Tribal regalia means traditional garments, jewelry and other adornments such as eagle feather, eagle plume, beaded cap, stole or similar objects of cultural and religious significance worn by members of a federal recognized Indian Tribe or Tribe of another country. Tribal regalia does not include any firearms or other weapons.
